8. Monuments to the 23 Seamen - Kaf Gimel Yordei Ha'Sira, May 1941	Jerusalem Mount Herzl ISRAEL	A symbol of 'Hagana' naval activity prior to the period of the Palyam	
9. Monuments to the 23 Seamen - Kaf Gimel Yordei Ha'Sira, May 1941	Tel Aviv, ISRAEL.	The list contains the name of British Major Anthony Palmer	
10. Graves in memory of the 200 who drowned on the vessel 'Salvador'	Jerusalem Mount Herzl, ISRAEL	Sank – December 1940

11. A monument to those who tried to make Aliya on the 'Struma' and the 'Mafkura'	Ashdod, ISRAEL	Both vessels sank in the Black Sea: Struma – Feb' 42 Mafkura – Aug' 44	
12. A monument to those who made Aliya on the 'Af Al Pi'	Netanya, ISRAEL	Af Al Pi – [Hebrew: despite all] - Aliya prior to WW-II that was organized by the Revisionist Party	
13. Atlit Detention Camp. It houses a record of Aliya Bet activity, a library, a team of lecturers, etc'.	 Atlit, ISRAEL	A reconstruction of the original British detention camp + 'Aliya Bet' vessel used as a living museum.	
14. A monument to the 'Exodus' and the nine other vessels, purchased in the USA	Baltimore, MD USA	These vessels sailed to Europe during the years 1946 – 1947, gathered survivors and brought them to Eretz Israel (Palestine).	
15. 'Struma' Synagogue and Museum	Beer Sheva, ISRAEL	The Struma was sunk by a Russian submarine in the Black Sea, Feb' 1942

<p>17. A monument to Machal Aliya Bet 1946-7 and Machal I.D.F. 1948-9</p>	<p>Sha'ar Ha'Gai, [on the road to Jerusalem], ISRAEL</p>	<p>This monument commemorates volunteers from various countries who participated in Israel's Aliya Bet and the War of Independence</p>	
<p>18. 'Sara'. a wireless radio station of the 'Hagana'</p>	<p>A hideout in Kvutzat Gvat, ISRAEL</p>	<p>This station was operative from 1939 – 1943 broadcasting from the Jewish Agency to London and New York</p>	
<p>19. A monument at the point of departure of the 'Exodus 47' to commemorate the immigrants to Eretz Israel-Palestine</p>	<p>The port of Sete, FRANCE</p>	<p>The ship sailed on July 11th 1947</p>	
<p>20. A lookout for the arrival of Aliya Bet vessels</p>	<p>The shore at Kfar Vitkin ISRAEL</p>	<p>In memory of the first Aliya Bet vessel, 'Velos', 1934</p>

<p>21. A monument to commemorate the voyage of the 'Pencho'</p>	<p>The shore at Netanya, ISRAEL</p>	<p>The 'Pencho' sank next to Kamila Nisi Island, Greece, in October 1940 The immigrants were shifted to Rhodes and then to Italy.</p>	
<p>22. A monument to the seven vessels that landed in Nahariya</p>	<p>The shore at Na'ariya ISRAEL</p>	<p>The last one, 'Gvura' is unknown</p>	
<p>23. A monument in memory of Binyamin Vitenberg</p>	<p>Kibutz Ein Gev Anchorage Kineret, (Sea of Galilee), ISRAEL</p>	<p>The first fallen member of Palyam who drowned on board the Vessel 'Lily', which sank, August 1943 The vessel was attacked by an Italian submarine, off Acre.</p>
